- The TxDot 256 rehabilitation through our town is about to begin construction. Utility line relocations began in August of 2025 and are scheduled for completion June of 2026. The utility contractors will begin work at the west end of 256 and move east towards downtown. Coordination is ongoing between TxDot, The City of Memphis, and the Utility Contractor to minimize impact and delays to the citizens of Memphis. We appreciate your patience while the upgrades are made to our town.
- The next City Council meeting will be on Monday, September 8, 2025, in the Council Room at City Hall beginning at 6:00 p.m. A list of the agenda items will be posted on the city website and the front glass at City Hall on Friday, September 3, 2025. There will be a public hearing at the beginning of this meeting for citizen comments on the proposed budget and tax rate.
- The Chamber of Commerce has booth rentals available for the annual Hall County Picnic to be held on Saturday, September 20, 2025. For more information on the schedule of events, visit their website at www.memphistexaschamber.com.
- The water department allows delinquent customers to make payment arrangements to bring their account current. All accounts with delinquent balances for more than two consecutive months must be paid in full to avoid disconnection. As a reminder, you can pay your water bill online at www.ThePaymentGroup.com. We also offer draft payments from any bank account. If you are interested, a form is available at the water office. You can drop your water bill payment in the fire hydrant drop box by the front door of City Hall. If you have any issues or questions about your water bill, please contact City Hall immediately.
- The city is dedicated to cleaning up the town. The landfill is FREE to Memphis residents and businesses except for roofing materials, appliances containing freon and demolition debris. There is a charge for those items and prices can be acquired by visiting the website or calling (806)259-3001. Landfill hours are Monday Saturday 8:00 am 5:00 pm and closed from 12:00 pm 1:00 pm for lunch. We also want to remind citizens that the alley behind your property is the homeowners' responsibility to mow and keep clean, that includes debris, tree limbs, and grass clippings. Please do not use the dumpsters to throw away grass clippings. We appreciate the City's effort in cleaning up our town.
- Great News!! e-Billing is now available. eBill is a FREE service that will allow customers to step away from paper bills, receive your bill by email, and be able to view your bill via an eBill eCommerce account.
- School is back in session. Please be cautious in school zones during the hours of 7:15 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. For a list of school activities visit their official website at www.memphisisd.org.
- The city will be fogging by vehicle for mosquito control in September prior to the Hall County Picnic, weather permitting. Watch for upcoming announcements with details for date and time.

- <u>Important Survey Request:</u> On our website you will find a survey for Service Line Inventory. If you can, please take the time to fill out the survey with as much information as you can. This survey is also available in paper format at the water office. If you have any questions please contact City Hall, 806-259-3001.
- Recently the Texas Utilities Code, Chapter 182, made customers' utility bill information
 confidential. This prohibits disclosing any information contained in your account to anyone who
 is not listed as the customer. The City has a form available that allows disclosure of your account
 information, if you give permission to do so. For more information or to request a form, please
 contact the Water Department.
- The City would like to encourage any resident that has a shelter or basement to contact City Hall or the Fire Department to have it on record, in case of bad weather. This information can be helpful to first responders in case of an emergency. The city has a public storm shelter located in the community center. Signs are posted on the outside of the entrance. When you hear the City sirens sound continuously for one minute, a tornado has been spotted, and you should seek shelter immediately. When there is one short siren, for a few seconds, all is clear, and it is safe to come out of shelter. The Memphis Volunteer Fire Department will be conducting siren test every 2nd and 4th Monday of the month. As a reminder, the Fire Department still has free smoke detectors. - If you see a streetlight out, you can report the outage to City Hall or online at the Southwestern Electric Power Company's website www.swepco.com.
